KEN BENNETT'S RECUPERATION

Ken is recuperating in the Townsville Hospital following injuries received when his vehicle left the gravel road and overturned near Weipa in mid-November, 2009. He suffered a stroke, received serious head injuries, a broken scapula and several cracked ribs.

Ken spent two weeks in Intensive Care, about eight weeks in the Surgical & Medical Wards regaining physical and mental stability and has now been in the Rehabilitation Ward for about six months. Here Ken receives physio sessions in the gymnasium twice daily, five days a week as well as occupational and speech therapy sessions. The emphasis is on getting movement and strength into his left arm and leg which were paralysed by the stroke and regaining his sitting and standing balance.

Ken is in a positive frame of mind and is mastering getting around in his wheel chair but is determined to walk again and enjoy a holiday by the beach. Recently, with the support of a frame, he was able to walk 40 – 50 metres – albeit very slowly.

On 25th August, Ken will transfer to Darwin Hospital where he will continue his rehabilitation. Here he will be close to his daughter, Rebecca and family.
